CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

AGNES EBERHARDT MEGO

of Kerby , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of 6 springs rising on applicant's land a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of Irrigation & Domestic, being 0.20 c.f.s. for irrigation & 0.02 c.f.s. for domestic under Permit No. 12389 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 26, 1936;

that the amount of water to which such right's entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second, being 0.13 c.f.s. from main spring and 0.09 c.f.s. from feeder springs,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW1SE1 of Section 16, Township 39 South, Renge 8 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10 acres in the NW1SE1 Domestic use in the NE1SE1 Section 16 Township 39 South, Range 8 West, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
