CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RALPH and HOMER BILLINGS

of Ashland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Gulch and spring, tributary of Bear Creek a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of Domestic, Mining & Stock, being 0.01 c.f.s. for Domestic & 0.01 c.f.s. for stock & 0.48 c.f.s. for mining, of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 12725 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 9, 1937;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second, being 0.40 c.f.s. from spring and 0.10 c.f.s. from gulch,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31, Township 38 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic, Mining and Stock in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 31
Township 38 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
