CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That U. A. McGRAE

of Wallowa , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed spring, seepage & Waste Water in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 14 & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 15 a tributary of Wallowa River (T. 1 N., R. 42 E., W.M. for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 12970 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 4, 1938;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 1 North, Range 42 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of one cubic foot per second per-acre, not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any 30 day period from May 1 to July 31 and thereafter shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during the remainder of the irrigation season ending October 1 and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion and shall not carry with it the right to divert water from the stream from which the waste water is diverted nor the right to require the wasteful use of water by others,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 14
Township 1 North, Range 42 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
