CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That U.S. FOREST SERVICE —UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST

of Pendleton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Spring at the head of Lookingglass Creek a tributary of Grande Ronde River for the purpose of Domestic, including irrigation of lawn not exceeding 1/2 acre in area & Fire Protection under Permit No. 13825 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 19, 1939;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 3 North, Range 38 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 33
Township 4 North, Range 38 East, W. M.

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 5
Township 3 North, Range 38 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
