CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That COOPER ANDERSON of P. O. Box 75, Carmel, State of California, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of An Unnamed Spring, a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of stock and domestic use under Permit No. 10763 of the State Engineer as modified by the Decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Washington County in the Matter of the Determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of an unnamed tributary and its tributaries, a tributary of the Tualatin River, being within Township 1 South Ranges 3 and 4 West, W. M. entered February 11, 1939; and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the Laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 9, 1932;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 1 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29
Township 1 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
