CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That HERMAN ANDERSON

of Box 282, Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
 the waters of Little Walla Walla River
 for the purpose of Domestic

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1898;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-tenth of a cubic
 foot per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

PLACE OF USE:

In NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 1

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-
 ing described tract: Commencing at a point 1212 ft. south and 30 ft. east of the
 northwest corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sect. 1, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence
 south 60 ft.; thence east at right angles 150 ft.; thence north at right angles
 60 ft.; thence west at right angles 150 ft. to the place of beginning.

ALSO: Commencing at a point 1212 ft. south and 30 ft. east of the northwest
 corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sect. 1, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence east 150
 ft.; thence at right angles north 30 ft.; thence at right angles west 150 ft.;
 thence south 30 ft. to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
