CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That MRS. ELIZABETH BALLOU

of R.#1, Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of

the waters of Meadow Brook, a Branch of Walla Walla River for Tract No. 1, and East Spring Brook for Tract No. 2, for the purpose of Irrigation for Tract No. 1, and Irrigation and Domestic for Tract No. 2

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1895 for Tract No. 1, and 1900 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

TRACT No. 1--11 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 23,
T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M.

TRACT No. 2- 1 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 24,
T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M.

(NOTE: The 2 acres is that portion of the said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ lying west of the stream commonly known as Spring Brook.)

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decrees.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
