## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That W. H. BLAHN

of Walla Walla, State of Washington, has a right to the use of  
the waters of East Prong of the Little Walla Walla River Spring Branch  
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority  
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half  
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant  
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

5.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 14,

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-  
ing described tract: Beginning at a point 61.5 rods north of the southeast cor-  
ner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 14, T. 6 N., R. 35 E., W.M., and running thence west  
609.5 ft.; thence south 352.25 ft.; thence east 609 ft.; thence north 352.25 ft.  
to point of beginning.

(NOTE: This right is restricted to the use of the waters naturally flowing in  
the East Prong of the Little Walla Walla River, Spring Branch.)

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
