CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That MATILDA A. BRIDGEWATER

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1895;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

3.73 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 1,
T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-
ing described tract: Beginning at a point 350 ft. north and 24.68 ft. west of
the southeast corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 1, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running
thence 261 ft. north; thence west 604.23 ft.; thence south 235 ft.; thence south-
easterly 20 ft. from the Walla Walla River 265 ft.; thence east 170 ft.; thence
northeasterly 196 ft. to point of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
