CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That

C. F. COLLINS

of R.#1, Freewater

, State of Oregon

has a right to the use of

the waters of Ford Branch of Little Walla Walla River

for the purpose of Irrigation and Domestic

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1885 for 3.5 acres, and 1893 for 4.5 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

8 acres in the NW4 of the SW4SE4 Section 35.

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tracts: Beginning at the northwest corner of the SW4SE4 of Sec. 35, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence south 30 rods; thence east 24 rods; thence north 30 rods; thence west 24 rods to the point of beginning, containing 4.5 acres more or less; reserving a right of way 16 ft. wide for road and ditch purposes across the south end thereof, and conveying a right of way for a road and ditch purposes a strip of land 16 ft. wide and 40 rods long extending east from the southeast corner of the above described tract of land. ALSO, commencing at a point 24 rods east of the northwest corner of the SW4SE4 Sec. 35, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence south 30 rods; thence east 18 rods and 6 ft.; thence north 30 rods; thence west 18 rods and 3 ft. to the place of beginning. ALSO, commencing at a point 37 rods and 5.5 ft. west of the center of the SE4 of said Sec. 35, running thence north 10 ft.; thence west 2 rods and 11 ft.; thence south 10 ft.; thence east 2 rods 11 ft. to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
