and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Cmatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1870;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

7.0 acres in NW4SW4 Section 1

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point 924 ft. east and 660 ft. south of the northwest corner of SW4 of Sec. 1, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M.; thence south 495 ft.; thence S. 10⁹ 24 W. 180 ft.; thence east 480 ft.; thence north 660 ft.; thence west 430 ft. to place of beginning, containing 16 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said 'ecree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
