CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MILTON BOX COMPANY

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Little Walla Walla River for the purpose of Water Supply for Mill Pond,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1900 for 4.5 miner's inches, 1893 for 1.05 miner's inches, and 1895 for 3.87 miner's inches, all to be measured at the point of diversion.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes; and shall not exceed 9.42 miner's inches.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

NW 1/4, Section 1,  
T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M.

(NOTE: This Certificate is issued to confirm a change in character of use of water approved by an Order of the State Engineer dated September 21st, 1932, pursuant to the provisions of Section 47-712, Oregon Code 1930.)

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
