## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That ELLA DOUGLAS

of Freewater, State of Oregon has a right to the use of  
the waters of Walla Walla River  
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority  
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1887;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half  
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant  
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-  
ing described tracts: Beginning at the southeast corner of Block 10 in the Town  
of Freewater, running thence east 340 ft.; thence north 125 ft.; thence east to  
the west bank of the Tum-a-lum River; thence northerly along the west bank of  
said river to the line running east-and-west through the center of Sec. 1; thence  
west along said center section line to a point due north of the place of begin-  
ning; thence south to the place of beginning. ALSO: Commencing at a point 397 &  
68/225 ft. east of the northeast corner of Block 11 in said Town of Freewater,  
thence east 52.82 ft. to the west bank of the Tum-a-lum River; thence E. 38° S.  
up and with the west bank of said river 330 ft.; thence S. 18° 55' W. 209.89 ft.  
to a water power right of way 36.68 ft. wide; thence N. 38° 10' W. along the  
east side of said water power right of way 392.4 ft.; thence north 91.29 ft. to  
the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
