CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That L. H. EBBERT

of R.#1, Freewater, State of Oregon has a right to the use of  
 the waters of East Prong of the Little Walla Walla River Spring Branch  
 for the purpose of Irrigation and Domestic

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
 Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority  
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half  
 miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant  
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

15.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
 20.3 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
 Section 15

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-  
 ing described tracts: Commencing at a point on the west line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec.  
 15, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., said point being distant north from the southwest  
 corner of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 15, 863.1 ft.; running thence north along  
 said west line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 15, 445.9 ft. to a stone; thence N.89° 01'  
 E. 187 ft. to a stone; thence N. 0° 39' W. 883 ft. to a stone on the State line  
 between Oregon and Washington; thence east along said State line 748 ft. to a  
 stone in the center of the County road; thence S. 0° 08' E. along the center  
 line of the County road 1155 ft. to a stone; thence southerly 19° 21' E. 197.9  
 to an iron pin in the center of said County road; thence west along the north line  
 of that tract of land conveyed to J. H. Wilson by Mary A. Wilson and recorded in  
 Book 73 of Deeds, page 232, records of Umatilla County, Oregon, 1004.1 ft. to the  
 place of beginning, containing 24.34 acres, more or less.

ALSO: Commencing at a point on the west line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 15, T.  
 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., said point being north of the southwest corner of said  
 NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 15, 457 ft.; running thence east parallel with the south line  
 of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 15, 1141.6 ft. to an iron pin in center of County road;  
 running thence northwesterly along the center of the County road 428.4 ft. to an  
 iron pin; thence running west parallel with the south line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec.15,  
 1004.1 ft. to west line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 15; running thence south 406.1 ft.  
 to place of beginning, containing 10 acres more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
 contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place  
 of use herein described.
