for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one half miner's inches per acre, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

2.0 acres in SHANNA 2.0 acres in NVASWA Section 14, 3.0 acres in SEANEA 2.9 acres in NEZSEA Section 15,

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point 30 rods and 10 ft. south of the corner of Fractional Sections 14 and 15 on the State Line between Oregon and Washington, in T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., and running thence west 22 rods 4 ft.; thence S. 0° 8' E. along road 39 rods 6.5 ft; thence east 40 rods 7.5 ft.; thence northerly 39 rods 6.5 ft.; thence wosterly 18 rods 3.5 ft. to the point of beginning, and containing 10 acres more or leas.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
