CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That HENRY EIFFERT

has a right to the use of

the waters of Ford Branch of Walla Walla River,

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1885 for 4 acros, and 1908 for 9 acros;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

7.5 acres in NELSWI 52a. Ch. Pt of Div. Sp. On Vol. 21 pH28 - 5.5 acres in NWISWI Section. 26,

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 52 rods east of the northwest corner of the SW2 of Sec. 26, T. 6 N., R. 35 E., W.H., running thence south 21 rods; thence east 16 rods; thence south 21 rods; thence east 12 rods; thence south 38 rods; thence east 17.5 rods; thence north 80 rods; thence west 45.5 rods to the place of beginning.

(NOTE: 4 acres of the 1908 right is restricted to the use of water up to June 1st of each year.)

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
