CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That **ELMA EVERETT**

of **Freewater**, State of **Oregon**, has a right to the use of
 the waters of **Little Walla Walla River**,
 for the purpose of **Irrigation**

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume **12**, at page **9**; that the priority
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from **1890**;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **one miner's inch**
 measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

**0.4 acre in NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄
 Section 2
 T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M.,
 Being Lots 1 and 2,
 Block 85 of the original
 Town of Freewater, Umatilla
 County, Oregon.**

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said decrees.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
