CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That CHARLES GERKE

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1865;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

2.4 acres in SW¹/₄NE¹/₄
Section 12

T. 5 N., E. 35 E. W. M., and being within the following described tracts: Commencing at a point in the middle of the old channel of the Walla Walla River at the upper side and near the north end of the County Bridge on the County Road leading by Brown's Mill to Milton, Oregon; thence westerly along the south side of said County road 20 rods; thence due south 9 rods; thence due east 15 rods to the middle of said old channel; thence to the place of beginning.

ALSO: Commencing at the beginning point of the above described land, thence northwesterly down and with the middle of said old channel 150 ft. to the middle of the Walla Walla River, where it now runs (said channel being now known as the Tumalum River); thence southwestly up and with the middle of the main channel about 255 ft. to the south side of said County road; thence northeasterly along the south side of said road about 255 ft. to the place of beginning.

ALSO: Beginning at the base of the bluff on the north line of Block 1, Riverside Addition to Milton, running thence northerly along the base of the bluff to the County Bridge or the approach thereto; thence westerly along said approach to the center of the old channel of the Walla Walla River; thence south-erly up the center of said old channel to the north line of Block 1 aforesaid; thence east along said north line of Block 1 to the place of beginning.

ALSO: All of Block 1 lying and being east of the Walla Walla River in Riverside Addition to Milton, Umatilla County, Oregon.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
