CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That NELLIE L. GREEN

of Freewater

, State of Oregon,

has a right to the use of

the waters of East Prong of Little Walla Walla Spring Branch

for the purpose of Irrigation and Stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 3; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-helf miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

1.3 acres in NW18W1 Section 14, 2.8 acres in NETSEL Section 15,

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: The N½ and the north 47 ft. of the S½ of the following described tract: Beginning at a point 70.5 rods west of the southwest corner of the N½S¼, Sec. 14, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence north 61.5 rods; thence west 32.5 rods to the center of the County road; thence southeasterly along the center of the road to the southwest corner of said N¼S¼; thence east about 10.5 rods to the point of beginning.

(NOTE: This right is restricted to the use of the waters naturally flowing in the East Prong of the Little Walla Walla Spring Branch.)

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
