and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Omatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 'one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

13.6 acres in NW SW Section 14

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point 36.5 rods west of the southeast corner of Nw4Sw4 of Sec. 14, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., and running thence north 61.5 rods; thence west 34 rods; thence south 61.5 rods; thence sest 34 rods to place of beginning.

(NOTE: This right is restricted to the use of the waters naturally flowing in the East Prong of the Little Walla Walla Spring Branch.)

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
