CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That MRS. LENA GROOM

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Stillman Branch of Little Walla Walla River,
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.95 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 1

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 658 ft. north and 515 ft. east of the southeast corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 1, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence south 264 ft.; thence east 173 ft.; thence north 245 ft.; thence west 169-1/3 ft. to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
