CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That LUCRETIA C. GROOM

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1887;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one miner's inch
measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.49 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 1

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-
ing described tract: Commencing at a point 638 ft. north and 299 ft. east of the
southwest corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 1, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence
south 50 ft. to the center of the channel of the Walla Walla River; thence up the
center of the channel of said river about 190 ft.; thence east along the north
bank of said river 20 ft. from the water's edge 131 ft.; thence north 267 ft.;
thence west 216 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 1 acre.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
