CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That GERALD G. GROVES

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1897;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

1.0 acre in NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄
Section 12

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point on the northerly line of George St. if said line were produced easterly in a straight line, 695 ft. easterly from the west line of Grover St. in Ireland's Addition to Milton; running thence easterly along said produced line of George St. 82 ft.; thence northerly at right angles 150 ft.; thence easterly at right angles 106 ft. more or less to the center of the channel of the Walla Walla River; thence northerly down the center of the channel of said river to a point distant northerly at right angles 386.25 ft. from said extended northerly line of George St.; thence westerly parallel with said extended line of George St. 84 ft. more or less to a point northerly at right angles from the point of beginning, said right angles being measured with the said extended line of George St.; thence southerly on a line drawn at right angles to said extended line of George St. 386.25 ft. to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
