## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That

has a right to the use of

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-helf miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant tor, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

3.9 acres in SWANWA 1.4 acres in NWASWA Section 14.

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 39 rods west of the northeast corner of the  $W_2$  of Lot 2 of the NW $_2$  of Sec. 14, in T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M.; running thence west 12 rods; thence south 70 rods; thence east 12 rods; thence north 70 rods to the place of beginning, containing 5.25 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
