CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That CLARA E. HARDY

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
 the waters of Walla Walla River
 for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority
 of the rig' thereby confirmed date: from 1880 for Tract #1, and 1908 for Tract #2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half
 miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract #1 - 5.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 3
 T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M.

Tract #2 - 0.7 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 3
 T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M.
 4.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 34,
 T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M.

NOTE: All of the above lands are within the following described tract: Beginning
 at the southwest corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 34, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running
 thence north 213.6 ft.; thence easterly 665.9 ft.; thence south 204.3 ft. to the
 south line of said Sec. 34; thence continuing south 588.3 ft. to the north line
 of the right-of-way of the OR&N Railway; thence westerly along said right-of-way
 724.4 ft. more or less to the north-and-south line running through the center of
 Sec. 3, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M.; thence north 285.4 ft. to the place of beginning,
 containing 10 acres, more or less.

NOTE: The right to the use of water under date of 1908 is limited to be used
 between October 15th of the year and June 1st of the following year.)

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
