## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. O. HENDRICKSON

R. #1, Box 144  
of Walla Walla, State of Washington, has a right to the use of  
the waters of West Prong of the Little Walla Walla River Spring Branch  
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority  
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1890;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half  
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,  
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

23.0 acres in SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>  
Section 15

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-  
ing described tract: Commencing at a point 1485.5 ft. west of the intersection of  
the quarter-section line running north and south through the center of Sec. 15,  
T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., with the line between the States of Oregon and Washing-  
ton, said commencement being the northwest corner of the land deeded to Konradh  
Knops by Solomon Dinges and wife on January 7, 1895; thence running south along  
the west line of said Konradh Knops' land 1198.6 ft. more or less to the land  
deeded to Ada E. Sayer by deed from the executors of the last will and testament  
of Dorsey S. Baker, deceased, dated Dec. 21, 1894; thence westerly along the  
north line of said Ada E. Sayer's land 695.5 ft. more or less to the southeast  
corner of the land sold by Solomon Dinges and wife by deed dated Mar. 9, 1895,  
to Stella Lenora Lobaugh; thence northwesterly along the east line of said Stella  
Lenora Lobaugh's land 258.46 ft. to the southeast corner of land sold by Solomon  
Dinges and wife to Catherine Maple by deed dated Mar. 9, 1895; thence northwest-  
erly along the east line of Catherine Maple's land to a point on the Oregon State  
line; which point is the northeast corner of said Catherine Maple's land; thence  
easterly along the Oregon State Line to point of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use  
herein described.
