CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That CLOVIS HERITIER

of R.#2, Freshwater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Waste Water from C. P. Collins and H. S. Shangle property southeast
from land of claimant,
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1907;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

5 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 33,

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-
ing described tract: Beginning at a point on the north line of the OWR&N Co.'s
right of way 304 ft. east and 1310.3 ft. south of the northwest corner of the
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 33, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence north 881.3 ft.;
thence east 660 ft.; thence south 508.3 ft. to the line of the OWR&N Co.'s
right of way; thence southwesterly along said right of way 763 ft. to the point
of beginning, containing 10.54 acres, more or less. EXCEPTING an 8-ft. right of
way on the south end of said land reserved to the Pleasantview Irrigation Co.,
and granting a 20-ft. roadway as now used connecting said tract with the County
road.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
