and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Unatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12 , at page 9 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1885 for 0.5 acre, and 1897 for 3.5 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

. A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

4.0 acres in SEINWI Section 35

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 16 rods south of the northeast corner of the SE of the SE NW of Sec. 35; T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence west 40 rods more or less to the west line of the SE of the SE NW of said Sec. 35; thence south 24 rods more or less to the center Sec. line; thence east 20 rods more or less to a point 20 rods west of the center of said Sec. 35; thence north 8 rods; thence east 20 rods; thence north 16 rods more or less to the place of beginning, containing 5 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
