CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MATTIE DE HILL

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Little Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1872;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

2.43 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 1,

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point where the north line of Main St. crosses the west line of Walla Walla St. in Freewater, Umatilla County, Oregon, running thence north along the west line of Walla Walla St. 150 ft.; thence west at right angles 200 ft.; thence north at right angles 215 ft. more or less to the OWR&N Co.'s railway right of way; thence southwesterly along said right of way 300 ft. more or less to the east line of Block G, in said town of Freewater; thence south along the east line of Block G, 240 ft. more or less to Main St.; thence east along said Main St. 450 ft. more or less to the point of beginning. ALSO: All of Block numbered E or 38 in Freewater, in said County and State.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
