CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W. C. HOPSON

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1877;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

7.3 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
29.69 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
1.55 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 20,

T. 5 N., R. 36 E. W. M., being within the following
described tract: Beginning at a point 2 rods south and 85.25 rods east of the
northwest corner of Sec. 20, T. 5 N., R. 36 E. W. M., running thence east
parallel with the north line of said Sec. 20, 35.5 rods more or less to the
south line of the county road; thence north 2 rods to the north line of said
Sec. 20; thence east 52.5 rods more or less to a point 47.5 rods west of the
northeast corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 20; thence south 80 rods more or
less to a point on the south line of the said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 20; thence
west 32.5 rods more or less to the southwest corner of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said
Sec. 20; thence south 13.5 rods; thence west 74.75 rods more or less to a
point south of the point of beginning; thence north 91- $\frac{1}{3}$ rods more or less
to the point of beginning, containing 60.75 acres more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use
herein described.
