.T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: The $SE_{1}^{L}SW_{1}^{L}$ of Sec. 36, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., EXCEPTING and especially reserving a strip of land 16 rods wide across the north side thereof, and also reserving the following described tract: Beginning at the southeast corner of said $SE_{2}^{L}SW_{1}^{L}$ of said Sec. 36, running thence north 120 ft.; thence west 510 ft.; thence south 120 ft.; thence east 510 ft. to the place of beginning. Containing 28 acres.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
