CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN HUBER

of R. #1, Milton, State of Oregon 97862, has a right to the use of the waters of North Fork Walla Walla River for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1895;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

6.1 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 23, T. 5 N., R. 36 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 300 ft. north of the southwest corner of NW 1/4, Sec. 23, T. 5 N., R. 36 E. W. M., running thence east parallel with the south line of said NW 1/4 of Sec. 23, 80 rods; thence north 62 rods more or less, to the center of said quarter-Sec.; thence west 80 rods to the west line of said Sec. 23; thence south along said Sec. line 62 rods more or less to the place of beginning, containing 31 acres.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
