CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. S. HURST

Box 284,
of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Little Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1872;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

4.04 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 1,

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the
following described tract: Beginning at a point on the north line of the OWR&N
Co.'s right of way, said point being distant 460.5 ft. north and 733.75 ft.
more or less N. 58° E. from the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner of Secs. 1 and 2, T. 5 N., R. 35
E. W. M.; running thence northwesterly at an angle of 90° with said line of
right of way a distance of 400.83 ft. more or less to the north line of the land
formerly owned by Frank Countryman, of which the present described land is a
part; thence along the north line of the said Countryman land, N. 58° E. a dis-
tance of 603.47 ft. more or less to the middle of the County road; thence south
a distance of 472.65 ft. more or less to the north line of the OWR&N Co.'s right
of way; thence south 58° W. along the line of said right of way a distance of
353 ft. more or less to the place of beginning, containing 4.4 acres, more or
less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use
herein described.
