CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. E. IRONS

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of

the waters of Walla Walla River for Tract #1, and Little Walla Walla River for Tract #2, for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880 for Tract #1, and 1886 for Tract #2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

TRACT #1 - - - 7.5 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4  
1.0 acre in NW 1/4 SE 1/4  
Section 2,

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: In Umatilla County, Oregon: Commencing at a point on the center line running north and south through Sec. 2, 48 rods south of the center of said Section; running thence east 13-1/3 rods; thence north 12 rods; thence west 13-1/3 rods to said center line; thence south along said center line 12 rods to the place of beginning. ALSO: Commencing at a point 6 rods and 24 ft. south from the center of said Sec. 2, where the south line of the OWR&N Co.'s right of way intersects the line running north and south through the center of said Sec.; thence northwesterly along the south line of said right of way 16 rods to a point 20 ft. south of the line running east and west through the center of said Sec.; thence west to the NE cor. of 1/2-acre tract deeded to Sarah A. Seeley being 20 ft. south and 14 rods 10 ft. west of the center of said Sec.; thence south 8 rods; thence west 10 rods; thence north 8 rods to the NW cor. of said tract; thence west parallel to and 20 ft. distant from said center line to the NE cor. of the James G. Thompson tract; thence south to a point 38 rods 3 ft. south of said center line to the NW cor. of the Elizabeth Goodman tract; thence southeasterly along the north boundary of said tract to a point on the N & S center line through said Sec., 36 rods, which point is 53 rods south of the center of said Sec.; thence north along said center line 45 rods 8 ft. to the place of beginning.

TRACT #2 - - - 9 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4  
Section 27

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at the SW cor. of the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 27, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence east 50 rods; thence north 48 rods; thence west 50 rods; thence south 48 rods to the place of beginning, containing 17 acres, more or less. AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said Decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
