CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LAURA F. JOHNSON

of Oakland, State of California, has a right to the use of the waters of Walla Walla River for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1895;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

5 acres in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract; Beginning at the southeast corner of the N 1/2 of the S 1/2 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence north 11 rods and 13 ft. to the place of beginning; running thence north 8 rods 13.5 ft.; thence west 80 rods; thence south 20 rods; thence east 34 rods more or less to the intersection of the south line of the Powell Ditch Company right of way; thence northeasterly along the said easterly line of the Powell Ditch right of way as the same is now located 53 rods 2.5 ft. more or less to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
