## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That A. C. and VERONICA KELNHOFER

of R. #1, Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Little Stream, a branch of Tumalum River  
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1892;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

7.5 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 36

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: The SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 36, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., EXCEPTING and reserving that portion thereof conveyed to J. E. George by deed dated April 30th, 1894, and recorded in Book 11 of Deeds, page 505, Records of Umatilla County, the same being a strip of land across the south side of the above described tract 212 ft. wide on the west end and 184 ft. wide on the east end thereof, leaving the tract hereby conveyed containing 7 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
