## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. D. KNAPP

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Little Walla Walla River  
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority  
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1903;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half  
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,  
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

1.28 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 1

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-  
ing described tract: Beginning at a point on the section line between Secs. 1  
and 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., 933.15 ft. north of the quarter-corner between  
said Secs. 1 & 2; running thence N. 58° E. 690 ft. more or less to a point 25 ft.  
south of the line running east and west through the center of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said  
Sec. 1; thence west parallel with and 25 ft. south of said line 522 ft. more or  
less to the west line of said Sec. 1; thence south along said section line 350 ft.  
more or less to the place of beginning. EXCEPTING and reserving therefrom the  
following described parcel: Beginning at a point on the Sec. line between Secs. 1  
and 2, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., 933.15 ft. north of the quarter-corner between  
Sec. 1 and 2; running thence N. 58° E. 499 ft.; thence westerly to a point on  
the Sec. line between said Secs. 1 and 2, 196 ft. north of the place of begin-  
ning; thence south to the place of beginning. ALSO EXCEPTING a right of way 4 ft.  
wide running northeasterly from the northeast corner of lands above described.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use  
herein described.
