CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHAS. LIGHTLE

205 1/2 S. 3rd St.,
of Walla Walla, State of Washington, has a right to the use of
the waters of East Prong of Little Walla Walla Spring Branch
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially-used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

4 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 14

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-
ing described tract: The west 4 acres of the following described tracts: Commenc-
ing at a point 682.25 ft. north of the center of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 14, T. 6 N., R.
35 E. W. M., thence east 665 ft.; thence north 336.25 ft.; thence west 665 ft.;
thence south 337.25 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 5.15 acres, EXCEPT-
ing however, 15 ft. on the north side thereof to be used for road purposes. ALSO:
Commencing at a point 682.25 ft. north and 665 ft. east of the center of the
southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of said Sec. 14, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M.; thence east
680 ft.; thence north 295.87 ft.; thence N. 58° 45' W. 83.5 ft.; thence west
638 ft.; thence south 336.25 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 5.24 acres,
EXCEPTING, however, 15 ft. on the north side used for road purposes.

(NOTE: This right is restricted to the use of the waters naturally flowing
in the East Prong of the Little Walla Walla Spring Branch.)

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use
herein described.
