## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That R. MAUD and WARREN M. LINEBAUGH

of R. #1, Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Springs, tributary to Walla Walla River for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1867;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

6 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 24

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point 60 rods south of the northwest corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 24, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence south 20 rods more or less to the line running east and west through the center of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 24; thence east 80 rods more or less, to the line running north and south through the center of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 24; thence north 20 rods more or less to a point 60 rods south of the north line of said Sec.; thence west 80 rods more or less to the place of beginning, containing 10 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
