CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILLIAM R. and ZOLA HELEN LOVE

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Ford Branch of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1892;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 20 miner's inches of water during the irrigation season up to June 15th of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

25 acres in NE¹/₄NE¹/₄
Section 27

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at the northeast corner of Sec. 27, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence west 1290 ft.; thence south 844.18 ft.; thence east 1290 ft.; thence north 844.18 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 25 acres.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
