CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARCUS R. McCOY and ROSE D. McCOY, ROWENA A. BOATMAN, L. HEIDENRICH, W. A. DUFF, MARY A. McCOY, GRACE PAULINE MADSON, and JOHN L. McCOY, by Mrs. I. R. McCoy, have a right to the use of

of Freewater, State of Oregon, the waters of Walla Walla River and Little Stream

for the purpose of Domestic and Stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12 at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 50 miner's inches.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

PLACE OF USE: In Sections 24 and 25, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., and Sections 19 and 30, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
