CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That SARAH E. MCINTYRE

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 19; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1866;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half
miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or,
if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

3.3 acres in NE¹/₄NW¹/₄
Section 12

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the follow-
ing described tract: Commencing at a point 130 ft. east of the northeast corner
of the intersection of George St. with the street originally called Grover St.
and now by some termed Mill St., in Milton City, Umatilla County, Oregon; running
thence easterly at right angles to said Grover St. 379 ft. 8 inches; thence north-
erly at right angles to said extended line 379 ft. 8 inches, a distance of 386 ft.
3 inches; thence westerly at right angles a distance of 379 ft. 8 inches to a
point 130 ft. westerly from said Grover St.; thence southerly at right angles a
distance of 386 ft. 3 inches to the place of beginning, containing 3.3 acres.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use
herein described.
