and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1891;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

5 acres in NWANEA Section 3

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point 2 rods west and 231 & 5/8 rods north of the southeast corner of the W_2^1 of the E_2^1 of Sec. 3, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence north 31 rods more or less to the line of telegraph poles on the OWREN Co.'s railway; thence northwesterly along the line of said telegraph poles as now located to a point 38 rods distant at right angles east from the line running north and south through the center of said Sec. 3; thence south parallel with said center Section line a distance of 40 rods more or less to a point of intersection with a straight line drawn from a point on said center line 257 rods north of the south line of said Sec. 3 to the point of beginning; thence in a southeasterly direction along said line a distance of $41\frac{1}{2}$ rods more or less to the place of beginning.
