CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

E. H. MAIDEN

of Milton

, State of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of Walla Walla River

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12 , at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1868:

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-helf miner*s inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

3 acres in NW4NE4 Section 12,

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: From the southeast corner of Block 1 in Ireland's Addition to Milton, in Umatilla Courty, Oregon, running easterly along the extended south line of said block, 617.4 ft. and southerly parallel with the center line of Grover St. 60 ft. to a place of beginning: Running thence easterly parallel with the extended south line of said Block 1, 130.5 ft.; being along the south line of an extension of Elzora St.; thence east along said south line of an extension of Elzora Street 165 ft. more or less to the center of the channel of the Walla Walla River; thence southerly up the center of said river channel 375 ft. more or less to the line running east and west through the center of the NE4 of Sec. 12, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M.; thence west along said center line 272 ft. to a point southerly at right engles with the extended south line of said Block 1 from place of beginning; thence extended northerly in a straight line 353.2 lt. more or less to place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other equivitions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
