CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That H. O. MANSFIELD

of Freewater , State of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of Little Walla Falla River

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilia County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Royal of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12 at page 1994. The three priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1988;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one miner's inch measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.17 acre in SWINE Section 2

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at the northwest corner of Lot 6, or Block 6, as it is sometimes called, in Evans' Addition to the town of Milton, as located in the City of Freewater, running thence south on the west line of said Block 6 to a point 6 ft. north of the east and west center line of said Block; thence easterly parallel with and at all times 6 ft. distant from said east and west center line for a distance of 60 ft.; thence north parallel with the west line of said Block 6 to a point on the north line of said Block and 60 ft. east from the place of beginning, thence west to the point of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
