## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That BELLE MANTZ

of R. #1, Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of East Branch of Little Walla Walla River, and springs on land, for the purpose of Irrigation and Domestic

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1907;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

5 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 24

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at the southwest corner of the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 24, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., thence west on the quarter-section line 25 rods; thence north at right angles 80 rods more or less to the north line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; thence east on the quarter-line at right angles 25 rods to the east line of said 40 acres; thence south on the quarter-line to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
