CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W. MARTIN

of R. #1. Freewater , State of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of East Prong of Little Walla Walla River Spring Branch

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measure at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

1.3 acres in NW4SW4 3.7 acres in SW4NW4 Section 14,

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point on the State line between the States of Oregon and Washington, 30 rods 24 links east of the line between Secs. 14 and 15, T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence west along said State line 11-3/7 rods; thence S. 12' W. 70 rods; thence east 11-3/7 rods; thence N. 12' E. 70 rods to place of beginning, containing 5 acres, more or less.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
