CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That . . . s. A. MILLER 30 1

of Freewater

, State of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of Walla Walla River for Tract No. 1, and Ford Branch of Walla Walla River for Tract No. 2, for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1883 for Tract No. 1, and 1901 for 19.42 acres and 1908 for 10.28 acres in Tract No. 2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one end one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

TRACT No. 1 -

7.03 acres in NW4NW4 Section 12 3 Ac. Tost Sp. Or Vol 13p. 52

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 40 rods south of the northwest corner of Section 12, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence south 40 rods; thence east 25 rods; thence north 16 rods; thence east 15 rods; thence north 24 rods; thence west 40 rods to the place of beginning, containing 8.25 acres, more or less.

TRACT No. 2 -

29.7 acres in NWINEL . Section 34

T. 6 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the E_2^{\downarrow} of NW4NE4, and the E_2^{\downarrow} of NW4NE4 of said Section 34.

(NOTE: The use of water (Tr.#2 only) is limited to the water available in excess of what is required to fill the permanent rights having a priority of 1908 or earlier.)

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
