and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Umatilla Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1872;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

> 0.81 acre in NWLNWL Section 12

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Commencing at a point 38 rods east and 30 ft. south of the northwest corner of Sec. 12, T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., running thence west 12.5 rods; thence south 16 rods; thence east 12.5 rods; thence north 16 rods to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
