CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W. H. FRAZIER

of Milton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Walla Walla River
for the purpose of Irrigation and Stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1865;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

4.03 acres in NW¹/₄ SE¹/₄
Section 12

T. 5 N., R. 35 E. W. M., being within the following described tract: Beginning at a point of intersection of the east line of Walnut St. with the south line of Frazier St. in Riverside Addition to Milton, as shown by the duly recorded plat thereof; running thence southerly toward the southwest corner of Block 12 in said Addition to a point of intersection with the center line of Walnut St.; thence northerly along said center line of Walnut St. to the south line of Frazier St.; thence easterly along the south line of Frazier St. to the place of beginning; and Commencing at the northeast corner of Block 13 Riverside Addition to Milton, Umatilla County, Oregon, running thence westerly along the north line of Block 13, 335.90 ft. to River St.; thence southerly along River St., 30 ft.; thence westerly along the line of said Block 13, 160 ft. to the northwest corner thereof; thence southerly along the west line of said Block 13, 241 ft.; thence easterly parallel with the north line of said Block 13, 500 ft. more or less to the east line thereof; thence northerly along the east line of said Block 13, 271 ft. more or less to the place of beginning.

AND said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
